



Projects



For the past 20+ years, we have performed the annual fundraising havan under a makeshift (rented) tent at the back of the temple. We have received divine blessings by performing various spiritual events at that place. For many years, as a community we have felt the need to build a permanent bhavya structure that could not only support fundraising havan programs, but also enable us to use the space for outdoor weddings, Diwali, Yoga, Holi, other outdoor community activities and much more. In 2022, we began working on a proposal to build a permanent structure about 50 feet X 100 feet (5000 sq. ft), referred to as the 'Spiritual and Recreational Center (SRC)' with the sincere hope that this will fulfill the growing needs of our community at large.

We received overwhelming support during the fundraising effort for the SRC. The snapshot below provides an overview of the same.

As the project moved forward with an overwhelming support, the input and requests of senior members to have a concrete floor instead of a gravel one, was accommodated.

Status and Next Steps:

The City of Augusta has approved the initial proposal (structure shown above with gravel floor) within a few months. When the request for a concrete floor was submitted, approval from multiple departments was needed. Meanwhile, The City of Augusta faced a cyber-attack, which also delayed the approval process. The final approval came towards the end of September 2023. With the holiday season approaching, discussions were initiated with contractors to engage with the project. Site preparation work began around mid-December. Below are the next steps and the suggested timeline for the project.

Site Preparations: Complete

Pier construction, building installation, inspections and turnover to HTS are expected to be completed in the next couple of weeks.
