Spiritual Lecture by Koti Sreekrishna

Koti Sreekrishna is an eminent biochemist and worked as a research fellow with the Baylor College of Medicine and the University of Kentucky. After working with Phillips Petroleum Company and Marion Merrel Dow, he is currently a senior scientist in the Global Biotechnology division at the Procter & Gamble Company.

In addition to his accomplishments in biotechnology, Dr. Sreekrishna is interested in philosophy, interreligious dialogue, and studying the Hindu scriptures. He has authored 3 books on Bhagavadgita (The Complete Bhagavad-Gita, The New Bhagavad-Gita and The Easy Bhagavad-Gita). He has previously authored a translation of the Purusha Suktam, a Hindu creation theme. He has served in the executive council of Hindu Society of Greater Cincinnati (HSGC) for several years and contributes articles to HSGC-Temple magazine.


